

Shepparton Outbreak Definitions

Primary close contacts

15 mins face to face or 2 hours in the same room with a confirmed case OR attendance at any of the following exposure sites:

Central Tyre Service, Welsford St

Any time from Wednesday 30 September to Tuesday 13 October

Mooroopna Golf Club Members Bar

Sunday 4 October and Sunday 11 October

Bombshell Hairdressing, 112 Fryers Street Shepparton

Wednesday 7 October after 9:30am

Thai Orchard Restaurant, 29 Nixon Street Shepparton

Wednesday 7 October from 7:00pm

Shepparton Market Place Medical Centre 31/110 Benalla Rd, Shepparton

Thursday 8 October 9.15am to 10.15am

Instructions for primary close contacts

Test now and quarantine for 14 days from last exposure to a confirmed case or any of the above exposure sites.

Have a further test on day 11 from last exposure to confirmed case or any of the above exposure sites and await clearance letter for release from quarantine.

Secondary close contacts – household and non-household

Definition: secondary close contacts are close contacts of primary close contacts

a) Household secondary contacts

Instruction: Request to isolate until household close contact is cleared from quarantine. Test if symptomatic at any stage or if the primary close contact tests positive for COVID-19.

If household **primary** close contact tests negative after the last time of exposure to the **secondary** contact, and if secondary contact moves to alternative accommodation, the secondary contact does not need to isolate and is released. Primary close contact will still need to complete quarantine. Any symptoms or if the primary close contact tests positive – test and isolate.

b) Non-household secondary contacts

Definition: Secondary close contacts who work in a sensitive setting e.g. school, ACF, abattoir.

Instruction: Request to isolate until **primary** close contact returns a negative test after the last time of exposure to the **secondary** contact. Primary close contact will still need to complete quarantine. Any symptoms or if the primary close contact tests positive – test and isolate

Casual contacts

Contact with a confirmed case that is less than 15 mins face to face or 2 hours in the same room OR attendance at the following exposure sites (where a confirmed case has visited for a shorter period of time):

Instructions for casual contacts

Get tested and stay at home while you await your results.

Be vigilant for symptoms – get tested again at the first sign of any symptoms.

The rest of the community in Shepparton

Anyone who is symptomatic (even mildly) should get tested and should isolate at home while awaiting their results.

Anyone else who is asymptomatic and comes for a test should be tested but is not required to stay at home while they await results.
